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### TUITION FEES

The Sydney Archdiocesan Catholic Schools Board has approved the following schedule of school tuition fees for 2022.

### EXPLANATION OF FEES

**Tuition Fee:** Fees set by Sydney Catholic Schools and cover all tuition costs.

**Building Levy:** This is a compulsory levy that is not tax deductible and is set by the Archdiocese of Sydney. The fee will be charged to the eldest child attending Sydney Catholic Schools (either primary or secondary).

#### **School Based Charges (All the items below are now incorporated into School Based Charges)**

**ICT Levy:** To cover the cost of recurrent ICT costs, local intranet site, technology support and maintenance, and purchase of equipment (software and hardware).

**Resource Fee:** This covers costs relating to Celebration/Reflection days, the College Magazine, school facilities for students, any major repairs, Library operative costs, cleaning, paper and general administration costs, including \$10 print credit for Year 7 students.

**Administration Fees:** Equipment / consumable items, together with excursions/incursions in relation to all subjects including electives.



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**Sports Fee:** This covers equipment, specialist sports contractors, hire of venues, bus hire, Sports and Swimming Carnivals. This does not include costs associated with Representative/Elective Sport.

**School Excursions:** Some school excursions may occur throughout the year and these costs are included under Administration Fees. All Camp/Retreat fees are charged separately and in advance. There are no refunds of Camp/Retreat fees unless due to illness approved by a medical practitioner and the College is advised 3 weeks prior to commencement.

### Payment of School Fees

Fees can be paid by Eftpos, BPay or Direct Debit via Credit Card on a fortnightly, monthly, or termly basis. BPay details are on your College Fee Statement.

Direct Debit is an automatic deduction from a Visa or MasterCard and there are no additional fees to use this option or to pay your account by instalments.
