EXPLANATION OF FEES

- Tuition Fee:** Fees set by the Catholic Education Office and cover all tuition costs.
- Building Levy:** This is a compulsory levy which is not tax deductible and is set by the Archdiocese of Sydney. The fee will be charged to where the eldest children attending CEO Sydney systemic schools (either primary or secondary).
- ICT Levy:** To cover cost of CEO recurrent ICT costs, local intranet site, technology support and maintenance, and purchase of equipment (software and hardware).
- Resource Fee:** This covers costs related to the electronic diary, the Tower Magazine, school facilities for students, any major repairs, Library operative costs, cleaning, paper and general administration costs including \$10 print credit for every student.
- Administration Fees:** Equipment and consumable items in relation to all subjects including electives.

Sports Fee: This covers equipment, hire of venues, bus hire, Sports and Swimming Carnivals. All students are levied the same amount irrespective of individual usage. This does not include costs associated with Representative/Elective Sport.

School Excursions: Some school excursions may occur throughout the year and will be billed separately. All Camp fees are charged in advance, there are no refunds unless a medical case.

Parent Engagement: This levy has been set by the Parent Engagement and Executive to assist the College in providing additional resources for your daughter.

Costs are correct at time of publication however may change if supplier prices increase.

Payment of School Fees

Fees can be paid by Cash, Direct Debit, Eftpos, BPay or BPoint. We are more than happy for you to pay your account fortnightly or monthly, termly and annually. To do this you would need to notify our Accounts Department who will set this up for you. Direct Debit from your bank account to the College bank account can be set up by you, through your online banking software.

BPoint is an automatic deduction from a Visa or MasterCard account on a fortnightly or monthly basis and there are no additional fees to use this option or to pay your account by instalments.
